Reversible thumb pistons: 10, *I-III, VI, VII*

Reversible toe pistons: 10, *II, VII, XII*

Combination couplers: *Great and Pedal pistons coupled*  
*Pedal combinations on swell pistons*  
*Generals on Swell toe pistons*
